Face Masks are to be Worn by ALL Persons entering the Club;  
*unless a written exemption can be provided on entry.*

### 1.0 Purpose

Bomaderry Bowling Club takes a very serious view of its responsibilities to its members, guests and staff.

We strive to maintain the safety and health of our members and staff, as well as adhering to the laws governing its operation.

All members and guests are asked to abide by these regulations and policies, to ensure a safe and comfortable environment.

Bomaderry Bowling Club has an obligation to protect its employees, members and guests from potential harm and through a common-sense approach request that all visitors to the club, assist the club in implementing this policy.

### 2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all persons entering the Bomaderry Bowling Club.

### 3.0 Definitions

PHO: Public Health Order

Exclusions: Under the Public Health Order there are a number of exclusions in relation to this policy which will be at the discretion of staff to implement.

### 4.0 Policy

This policy is intended for the protection, Health and Wellbeing of persons entering the club. It is understood that a number of exemptions may apply under the PHO and the Club will comply with such exemptions, although will respectfully seek to view written exemptions to the PHO before permitting entry.

The Club will treat all members and guests with dignity and respect and will not seek to identify an individual's reason for such exemption of this policy.

Instead, we would like to make a reasonable request that: Prior to entry to our club you have a document of exemption which may be supplied by a duly qualified professional, of which you should carry on your person and on request make available to staff or regulatory officials as required such an exemption.

We ask this of our customers, as we are committed to doing our best to comply with the infectious nature and fluid conditions of Covid-19 pandemic of which we need your support.

As the club recognises that we have a number of vulnerable people who enter our club, including people from diverse ethnic backgrounds, social, medical and associated health concerns and also to the legal responsibility to staff to occupational health and safety, we believe this Policy is in the best interests of a majority of our customers and staff and is in no way intended to discriminate or treat any person differently due to a person exercising an exclusion to this policy.

The Covid-19 pandemic is real and has real consequences, not only the health and wellbeing of people, but also a severe economic impact to our patrons, staff and the Bomaderry Bowling Club which could occur due to not taking what we consider to be reasonable steps to prevent spread of Covid-19.

#### 5.0 Procedure

Any person entering the club, (during the PHO – Face Mask Mandate) should either be wearing a face mask on entry OR at the reasonable direction of staff supply written exemption to the wearing a face mask.

We will not make any unlawful inquiries in relation to your individual exemption and will treat any information provide in confidence.

Should our staff have concerns in relation implementing this policy or should such a reasonable request not be accommodated by any person entering the club, you may be denied entry and this matter will be referred to the appropriate regulatory authorities.
